InSite-Edu™ is a new teaching tool aimed at both undergraduate and graduate level, that includes the key components and functionality of InSite Seismic processing software and is available to accredited degree-granting educational institutes worldwide.

InSite-Edu is managed through a digital network floating licence, enabling multiple students to access the software simultaneously and conveniently either remotely or on site (e.g. on the university campus). The teaching material provided with InSite-Edu includes tutorials and example datasets to help guide the student through the main steps in the processing, visualisation, and analysis of seismic data. Technical support is provided for twelve (12) months.

Please note that InSite-Edu is not available for any commercial use including revenue-generating purposes and/or consulting.
